

Voting Guide for UNCW Students



Qualifications to Vote

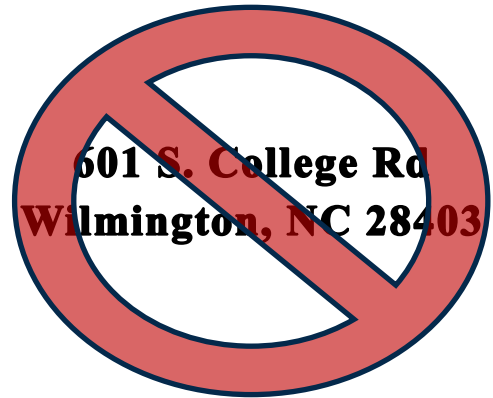
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must be a resident of New Hanover County and lived at residence for 30 days prior to the Election
- Must be at least 18 years old or will be 18 by the date of the next general election
- Must not be serving a sentence for a felony conviction (including probation or parole)



Precinct W24 Polling Place is UNCW Warwick Center. Visit NHCVOTE.com to check your polling location.

Election Day Essentials

- Present at polling place in precinct of registration
- Allow plenty of time to complete the process in case lines are long
- Only voters registered in New Hanover County will be able to vote traditionally at their polling site. All other voters will have to vote provisionally.



If you live on-campus, you will need to list the physical address **OR** the name of the facility that you live in (ex. Belk Hall). *Using the main address of the university will **NOT** satisfy the residency listing.* A mailing address (home or campus box) is also required for on-campus students.
